The dunny modules we have used are no longer manufactured. We have 30-40 in stock, some with broken lids Bryce proposed the "Recycled box and dunny seat", manufactured for \$14.30 + liner bag. Gives a very low seat. 30% squats would reduce costs.

Site: David Symons - site visit on weekend:

Site has great shade, beaches, firewood.

Also has some problems:

Site road runs through owners backyard. Solution: we move a woodpile which gives us straight road access to rear gate. Car park is some distance from site: we will need more hand trolleys. Very close to town & neighbours: loud music may be a problem. We'll have to discuss this Front paddock is irrigated - no vehicle access. Cattle: we'll need to install an electric fence so gates can be left open.

Levee bank: Need to fill either side so it isn't so steep. Cattle trucks drive over levee, so water trucks should be okay.

Lease has arrived. Separate letters regarding cost of moving cattle off property (if owner deems it necessary 'cause we destroy all the cattle's feed), owners children's access to property during lease period.

Rhonda: Fire strategies & speedboats

Motion: That the site map and pictorial location be taken off the

website. Proposed Yeroa Bindy, Seconded: David Symons. Consensus

Presentation: Michael and Joe. Nuclear Free Village with representatives

from MAUM, Jabiluka etc. Budget proposal to come.

Finance: Laurie re telephone expenditure and petrol expenditure for DTE people. Village budgets to cover village expenditure on telephone and petrol. Phone: individuals to present records to cover cost of calls, not rental, as before. Fuel: Laurie to draw up a form to cover kms travelled.

Presentation: Fire Strategy: Anthony. 10 point plan.

- 1. Hand out leaflets at front gate.
- 2. Clear signs: signs to be constructed before ConFest. (eg Fire in safe firepits only, communal firepit here, A safe fireplace looks like this etc) "Total Fire Ban Today" signs to be stored at information.
- 3. Communal firepits to be dug by backhoe at village sites.
- 4. Fire patrols
- 5. Training
- 6. Buckets + 44's to be kept filled with water (+ detergent so the water won't be used for drinking)
- 7. Communications: Emergency mobile contact with CFA (available 24 hours/day)
- 8. Manual fire-fighting equipment: Sacks, polaski, macleod's, safety goggles, dust masks, detergent, buckets (150). Borrowed from CFA, BFB etc.
- 9. Powered fire-fighting equipment: 2 quad bikes, 2 petrol or diesel powered water pumps and hoses on trolleys

Road-building water tanker

BFB fire-fighting vehicle

10. Co-ordination: Fire Safety Working Group

Fire Safety Committee: Brad, Laurie, Steve, Paul, Simon, Anthony, Paula (co-opted)

Discussion: Site Layout. Road and vehicle access, don't push site up too far, levy bank as barrier, possible locations for spiral, market, car park, move front gate/techno to road, retain open space. To be discussed again.

Discussion: Water and power: David S. Take water from downstream arm of river and run to marketplace, supply power to coolrooms. Issue of cars running over polypipe. Proposal to lay polypipe now while ground is soft. Alternative energy rather than using the power grid. Run power from house to workers kitchen. ConFest has already reduced power needs to a minimum: runs off one 15 amp & one 10 amp (coolroom) circuit. Health issues a concern: power for first aid, food refrigeration. Water and power committee: Brad, David S., John, David C. Peter C., Laurie, Richard Swinton

Discussion: Drug and Alcohol Policy: Yeroa.

DrugFest. Prevalence of drugs. Young folk having drugs pushed on them. Dealing with OD's. Rick: imposition of our values, freedom. Some villages value drug-free status: Spiral, Spiritual, Yoga, Children's. Need to create drug and alcohol free zone on site: where to position such space(es) relative to each other. Consensus on drug and alcohol free-space.

Newsletter: Ready tomorrow: Folding/Labelling: volunteers at David C's this weekend: Mattie, Cheryl, Mary etc. Use green poster (ship) until new poster presented.

Motion: That up to \$1500 be allocated for 100 main + secondary bamboo poles. Moved: Steve Herrmans. Seconded: Simmeau. Consensus.
