AGENDA ITEMS

1. WEB

PETER T: would like be granted access to dte.coop and confest.org.au domains. ICT group been pushing me out, I've been actively helping out. Created a 3-table database for use by MARTY. Hope to create forums for use by participants. ROBIN has denied me access because I'm not a member.

ROBIN: I think PETER's contribution has been good on the tech side. We need member data to be protected. As such, non-member access to the entire membership details should perhaps be restricted. We may be able to give restricted access to get stuff done without risking exposure of private data. I think ICT hasn't been shutting you out, and that the ICT group hasn't been very active.

JENNI: Who has admin access?

ROBIN: Different forms of admin access. Some of which don't have private detail access. Let's look at how we can carefully grant access (without super-user privileges).

TROY: Extraordinary that a non-member is petitioning the board for overruling a self-driven committee. There are ways to empower Peter to allow him to do what he wants to do; managing the domain is separate from having admin of a content management system. Fully support Peter having a domain of the DTE website that he can admin, but having domain management control is not required for him to publish the website.

FULVIO: What do you need this access for?

PETER T: I've got access to backend access to Joomla, but I can't currently do anything (e.g. upload stuff) with that. Uploading one document can take 10 emails. NO ACTION TAKEN.
