	Agenda details: Every month we pay \$205 for bin rental. This is the cost of 5 bins (although we actually have 6 on site). CWS will charge \$294 for a truck to travel from Deniliquin to Moulamein to remove the bins. There will be an additional emptying charge of \$74 for each bin that has rubbish in it. The maximum it will cost to remove the bins is \$738 if each of the six bins contain at least a little rubbish.
