| | That the following changes be approved from the close of this GM, for working bees: 1 / No food or accommodation costs getting to or from Woorooma or Bylands sites for a working bee will be covered by DTE. 2 / On Woorooma or Bylands sites an allowance of \$11 per person per day for food and non alcoholic drinks during the working bee. 3 / The maximum round trip fuel claim or public transport with receipts for volunteers coming to Woorooma or Bylands sites for a working bee is :- Travelling from :- Victoria \$ 150, South Australia \$ 225, New South Wales \$ 300, Queensland \$ 500. However volunteers on onsite for less than four days may only claim a pro rata rate. ie. Two days on site only 50%. 4 / When travelling more than 70 kilometres off the Woorooma or Bylands sites during a working bee to pick up a person, materials or supplies, up to \$20 per person allowance for lunch with receipts may be claimed. 5 / Volunteers are expected to fill in a timesheet putting in an average of 4 hours per day overall at a working bee ie. 6 hours a day for two days followed by a day of play and rest or 5 hours a day for four days followed by a day of play and rest, etc. Background info: After a raft of motions where passed recently, it has been inappropriate to use DTE money for food or fuel, therefore I am proposing this motion to outline a structure and the appropriate use of DTE money for the explicit use at working bees only.
